The Position

The Greater Bendigo Strategic Partnership project will build the cultural inclusion of those of refugee background, asylum seeker and culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) communities. The partnership involves City of Greater Bendigo, Bendigo Community Health Services (BCHS) and Loddon Campaspe Multicultural Services. Each partner will work to implement components of the project.

BCHS' focus will be on building the health literacy of the target groups using a peer education model.

The provision of Australians rights and responsibility education is also included in the project.

The position requires current experience in working with those of refugee background, asylum seeker and CALD communities and developing health programs and project management.

A qualification in Public/Community Health/Community Development or other relevant qualification and/or experience in the field is required for this role.
