The Position

This position sits within the headspace Bendigo program. The primary focus of the headspace team is to support the health and well-being of young people through services and linkages; improve community awareness and understanding of issues for youth and the impact on their mental health; lead coordinated care and referral pathways internally and externally across a range multidisciplinary service.

This position will work closely with other headspace staff and in collaboration with the General Practitioner and the clinical team, providing high quality clinical mental health assessment and appropriate counselling and consultation duties focusing on young people 12 to 25 years.

headspace is seeking an applicant with:-

- 1. Approved tertiary qualifications in a relevant discipline and eligibility for membership of an appropriate professional body and accreditation/credentialing to work as a Mental Health Clinician.
- 2. Qualifications enabling the completion of assessment, care planning, case co-ordination and management of young people aged 12 25 years, who may have a range of physical, emotional and mental health and wellbeing issues.
- 3. The ability to provide practice that is sensitive to client diversity.
- 4. The ability to participate in clinical, operational and group supervision and a commitment to critical reflection and discussion of values and ethical conduct.
