## The Position

The Strategic Partnership Project (SPP) purpose is to build the capacity and health literacy of those of refugee background, asylum seekers and residents of non-English speaking background. This is integral to ensure optimal settlement, self-reliance and enhancement of health status and prevention of chronic disease.

The project will develop peer education models and education sessions to address the health issues identified by community and service providers.

The role of this position is to provide administrative, language support and cultural guidance to staff working on the SPP and to engage with the community of interest to help inform the project. This will include arranging and promoting events within the Refugee Community of Bendigo, providing cultural guidance to inform program and event development and co-facilitation of events and education sessions.
