Primary Health Care Services Organisational Support and Business Development Community Medical Practitioner - Sexual and Reproductive Health 76.0 hours per fortnight (negotiable) Ongoing

The Position

Bendigo Community Health Services (BCHS) currently operates three medical practices (Eaglehawk, Central Bendigo and Kangaroo Flat). These are bulk billing clinics and work in association with the broader network of community services offered by BCHS.

BCHS are seeking a highly motivated, self-starter with the clinical and interpersonal skills to lead a team in sexual and reproductive health. This position requires the following competencies and capabilities:-

- Knowledge and awareness of factors that affect the ability to conceive a child;
- Understand and be committed to processes and systems being in place to provide safe and equitable fertility control services;
- Delivering contemporary practice to enable Victorians to exercise their reproductive rights;
- Providing general practice support and skills in early diagnosis, effective treatment and management of specific reproductive health issues, such as endometriosis, polycystic ovary syndrome and menopause;
- Provide medical intervention and advice on prevention, early diagnosis and treatment of sexually transmissible infections (such as chlamydia).

Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency as a Medical Practitioner and fellowship with ACCRM or RACGP is required for this position.

Salary and conditions of employment are in accordance with the Medical Practitioners Award 2010.
