The Position

The Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) Services team is a multidisciplinary team providing a range of AOD services and programs on an individual, family or group basis within a harm minimisation and recovery framework. Service and program streams include assessment and treatment planning, general and forensic AOD counselling, care and recovery coordination, residential and community-based withdrawal, family supports, pharmacotherapy, harm reduction and community education. The focus of the team is to provide seamless treatment pathways, coordinated and holistic treatment and supports for consumers to a range of internal and external services.

The successful applicant will be a Registered Nurse (Division 1) with current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA). They will demonstrate knowledge of the complex health and psychosocial needs of persons affected by the use of alcohol and other drugs and have the expertise to undertake comprehensive assessments and provide direct health treatment and supports to persons with alcohol and other drugs issues in a non-judgmental and sensitive manner.
