Bendigo Community Health Services (BCHS) has managed a suite of refugee settlement services for over nine years with the key target groups including the Karen, Afghan and South Sudanese communities.

BCHS have identified isolated families of refugee background who do not actively participate in civic life, have poorer health and service literacy despite participating in BCHS' settlement programs on arrival.
