The Position

Child Health Invest (CHI) is a small multidisciplinary team which includes Paediatricians, Paediatric Registrars, Mental Health Nurses and Allied Health Professionals. CHI works collaboratively to provide comprehensive health and wellbeing assessments to vulnerable families within the community. Many of the CHI families present with complex needs and the CHI team responds holistically, addressing the presenting needs and endeavoring to refer to other complimentary services, enhancing outcomes for children, youth and families.

To be successful in applying for this position you will have:

- 1. A tertiary qualification and experience related to the role of Child and Adolescent Counsellor for clients across the age continuum.
- 2. Significant experience working with children and adolescents.
- 3. Relevant credentialing, enabling the provision of therapeutic services funded under Medicare and Primary Health Network (PTS, Mental Health Plans etc).
- 4. Demonstrated skills and knowledge in providing therapeutic services informed by:
 - a) Trauma and attachment informed practices
 - b) An understanding of intergenerational poverty
 - c) Early brain development
 - d) Impact of family violence on children and families
