Yee wëël yindë yen yennë kÿc toom ku ye luui wudë në kÿc gup?

What is a vaccine and how does it work?

Wëël yennë kÿc toom ee wëël ye kuçony gäm kÿc ago bairäth ya nyaai në kÿc gup të cen keek dÿm. Ë bairäth kënnë ee tuaany ye rÿt thiäi piny në kem ke kÿc juëc.

Wëël yennë kÿc toom ee guÿpdu cÿk ril (tuentyuëeny tiëstwei në yî guÿp) ago guÿpdu tuany ya dÿc deet ku bî ya thÿÿr kënnë yen agut cî bî tuaany cuÿpwei në yî guÿp. Na tom yîn në ye wëël kënnë, ke guÿpdu abî tuany ya deet ku bî dÿc ya cuÿpwei në yî guÿp ago cië beer ya tuaany wennë ka bî tuany ya tiaam ago ya dÿng ke ye kë thiin koor cîi lëu bî yîn beer tiaam. Yîn cîi lëu ba bairäth ya yÿk të cennë yîn toom guÿp në ye wëël kënnë.

Yîn cî kÿn ya tom guÿp wënthëer në wel juëc kÿk në pîrduic ago yîn ya tiit guÿp në tuentyuëeny juëc cîi men de ñÿl (polio), tetaniith (tetanus) ku ajuäk (measles).

Ye wëël yennë kÿc toom kënnë ya wëël pieth cîn tuany dët peei ye gäm kÿc?

Are vaccines safe?

Acîn tuany dët peei bikkë ya gäm kÿc. Në Authërelia ëtënnë, ke wel ye keek dek ku wel yennëke kÿc toom aye keek kÿn them në thëe juëciic ago keek kÿn ya deet men luuikë apieth ku bikkë tuany cî juiëër keek ya nyaai në kÿc gup. Acîn wëël bennë kÿc ya toom të cennë yen yÿk ke cîi bî ya piath kënnë kÿc. Ago wäl ya gäm kÿc, ke ka ye kÿn them në thëe juëc yiic arëetic në kë nÿngë Authërelia lööng



juëc yennëke wal kÿn them ago jal gäm kÿc. Ë thëm de wal kënnë aye looi në akutnhom de Akîim (Department of Health) tënnë Akuma de Authërelia. Yen ajuiëer kënnë aye colë “Therapeutic Goods Administration” në thoſ de Liſjëlith, men lëu bî geeric në thoſda ke ye mäny pieth lëu bennë töök de tuentyuëeny ya mac në kÿc gup.

Tuöm pieth lëu bennë raan ya toom yennëke kuer tÿng thiekic lëu bennë yîn ya tiit guÿp, wennë kÿc ke paanduön ku wunduön ëbën agokë bairäth cië ye beer dÿc dÿm.



Yeenjō yennē wēēl de KOBIT-19 yennē kōc toom gup ku ye wēēl pieth cīn tuany dēt peei ye gām kōc? What is the COVID-19 vaccine and is it safe?

Wēēl de Koronabairāth (KOBIT-19) yennē kōc toom gup, ee guōpdu piōōc ago tuany de KOBIT-19 ya nyic mēn cen yīn dōm guōp ku bī ya thōōr kennē yen agut cī bī ya nyaai ētaiwei nē guōpduc. Wel cī bēnbei nē yemēen ēke yennēke kōc toom gup aye keek cōlē (Pfizer ku AstraZeneca) ku ka tō nē Authērelia yic ēbēn ku ka cī keek them arēētīc nē thēe juēc yīic ku ka cī rōth nyuōōth ēke ye tuany de KOBIT-19 nyaai nē kōc gup. **Na cī yīn toom nē ye wēēl kēnnē, ke yīn cī lēu ba bēer ya tuany nē ye tuany kēnnē.**

Cī mēn de wēl cennēke yīn kōn toom guōp wēnthēer, ke wēēl kēnnē abī ya tuōōm nē aṅōknhom nē yīn kōk. Yīn bī ya toom nē wieth keerou nē nīn yīic keerou nē ye wēēl kēnnē. Kōc kōk aye tuanytuēeny thi kōk yōk tē cennē keek toom nē ye wēēl kēnnē, cī mēn de tōōk de tē cennē wāl wuōm thīn nē kōk nhom, aṅarnhom wennē atuōc (alēēth) thīin kor. Ē tuanytuēeny thi kōk ye keek gām kōc aye kā niōp ye dōc jāl nē kaam de nīn lik ku ka cīn kē lēu bīn ya diēer nē keek. Na ye tuanytuēeny thīi kākē yōk ēke cī yīn keek diēer, ke yī jaamē wennē akīmdu. Ē wēēl kēnnē acīi kōc ye dōc gām tuanytuēeny kōk rilīic.

Ēwēēl kēnnē alāāu tēnnē raan ēbēn tō nē Authērelia ku yīn lēu ba ya lōc mēn bennē yīn ya tom nē ye wēēl kēnnē wennē cīi yīn bī toom nē yen. Ee yīn yītōk yīnnēka bī yen ya lōc mēn bī yīn ya toom nē ye wēēl kēnnē nē kē yen ya yīn yītōk yīn ye guōpdu mac, ku cie kē lēu ben yīn ya gām tuanytuēeny kōk peei wennē cīi lēu bī ya luui apieth kennē yīn.

Kōc kōk aalēu bīkkē ya ṅoot ēke dōm tuany de KOBIT-19 keek tē cennēke wum nē wēēl de KOBIT-19, ku na yīn ya, ēka thiekic ba rōt ya tiit yītōk:

Ye kōōc ke yī nōṅ kaam bāāric amāāth tēnnē kōc kōk peei, ye yīcin dōc waak nē thabuun ku pīu wennē tōc yīcin nē wēēl yennē kām nōk nē kōc cin, ye cieṅ nē kē yennē kōc ke thook ku ke wum kum ku rēērē paanduōn tē ye yīn rōt yōk ke yī cīi guōp piōl. Aṅoot ke thiekic ba yī guōp ya cōk them nē tuany de KOBIT-19 tē ye yīn rōt yōk ke yī cīi ye tuany kēnnē dōm.

Ago wēlkuōōn kōōr keek ya kōn kuen ago kēpieth ya tak nē rōtdu wennē tēnōṅ paanduōn, ke yīn lēu ba ya jam wennē Akīmdu (Dīktor du) nē kē de tuany ē KOBIT-19, ku yeenjō yennē yicthiek de tuōōm de ye wēēl kēnnē ago wut ēbēn ya cōk piōl guōp ku bīkkē ya ciēn tuanytuēeny.

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What is a vaccine and how does it work?

A vaccine is medicine that helps people fight a virus if they have contact with it. A virus is an illness or disease that can spread from one person to another person.

A vaccine makes your body stronger (immune system) so that your body can quickly recognise and fight a virus. When you have a vaccine, your body will remember the disease and quickly stop you from getting sick or will make the sickness less serious. You cannot get a virus from having a vaccine.

You have already had many vaccines in your lifetime to protect you from diseases like polio, tetanus and measles.

Are vaccines safe?

Yes. In Australia medicine and vaccines are tested many times to make sure they are safe and that they will do what they say they will. No vaccine will be given if they are found to be unsafe. Approving a vaccine takes a lot of time because Australia has strong safety requirements. This testing is done by part of the government's Department of Health. It is called the Therapeutic Goods Administration.

Having a vaccine is one of the fastest ways to protect you, your family and the community from a virus.

What is the COVID-19 vaccine and is it safe?

Coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccine teaches your body how to know if COVID-19 is in you and how to fight it. The two different vaccines (Pfizer and AstraZeneca) available in Australia have been tested many times and show they are very good at stopping people getting very sick or dying from COVID-19. If you have the vaccine, you are less likely to get sick.

Just like other vaccines you have had, it will be given to you with a needle in your arm. You will need to have two needles on two different days. Just like other vaccines, some people will have mild side effects like a sore arm where the needle went in, headache or mild fever. This is very normal and should not last longer than a few days. If your side effects are making you worry, you can talk to your doctor. Serious side effects are very rare.

It is free for everyone living in Australia and you can choose if you have the vaccine or not. It is voluntary because we all have the right to control what we do with our bodies, not because it is not safe or effective.

This vaccine is safe and effective.

Some people might still get COVID-19 after having the vaccine so it is important that you still:

Keep your distance from other people, wash your hands well with soap and water or use sanitiser, wear a mask and stay home if you are not feeling well. It is still important to get a COVID-19 test if you are feeling sick.

To make sure that you have the information you need to make the best decision for you and your family, you can talk to your doctor about COVID-19, and why the vaccine is important to keep the community safe and healthy.
