**The Position**

The Alcohol and Other Drugs (AOD) Care and Recovery Coordination (CRC) Practitioner is responsible for working with consumers to coordinate their treatment, planning and care in accordance with their recovery goals. The role engages consumers in a thorough and comprehensive assessment of their needs developing a responsive recovery plan that addresses both short to long term goals. The position will support the development of integrated treatment pathways for community members assessed as being complex and who often require support through Bendigo Community Health Services (BCHS) Residential Withdrawal Program.

**To successfully apply for this position you will need:**

1. A tertiary qualification in a related area of health and/or community services
2. Experience in the provision of assessment and brief intervention services within the Alcohol and Other Drugs sector.
3. Proven ability to effectively work with people and families experiencing disadvantage from alcohol and other drug use in a respectful, compassionate, and positive manner.
4. Ability to provide vaccination status information that meets the requirements for healthcare workers.
