We are seeking a candidate who can read and speak Dari and English, has an interest in assisting the Karen community to understand their health and to assist in seeking the care they need. Experience in working with refugee communities (volunteer or paid) is preferred.

To successfully apply for this position you will need:

- 1. An ability to write, read and speak in English and Dari, language.
- 2. An interest to learn about project management, community needs analysis, program design and evaluation, and improving health and wellbeing.
- 3. Demonstrated communication skills and community engagement.
