- Disability employment: For those who are living with a disability and wanting to engage in employment/study.
- Transition to work: For young people aged between 15-21 years who are considered at risk of long-term unemployment and require assistance to enter in vocational and employment opportunities.
- Jobs Victoria Employment Network (JVEN): Assists clients who are unemployed to build and develop skills to reenter the work force.
