The Position

- The position of Mental Health Clinician sits within the headspace Bendigo Youth Mental Health team. The focus of the role is to provide evidenced based therapeutic interventions to consumers aged 12-25 years including consumers of diverse backgrounds.
- The primary role of the Mental Health Clinician is to work within the headspace multidisciplinary team providing early intervention mental health support to young people aged 12-25 years and their family and friends. The position will conduct psychosocial assessments and deliver evidence-based short-term psychological interventions.
- Headspace Bendigo are seeking a candidate with a tertiary qualification in a relevant discipline with current / or pending registration with the Australian Health Regulation Agency (AHPRA) or membership of the Australia Association of Social Workers (AASW).
