The Position

The Community Health Program is an initiative funded by the Victorian State Government and is designed to provide high quality mental health services to adults who are currently completing Correction Orders or on Parole and where these orders have a Mental Health and Treatment Rehabilitation (MHTR) condition. Improved mental health outcomes and reduced recidivism are the main desired outcomes of the service. The service will be delivered by a multidisciplinary team of mental health professionals who will provide assessment and treatment to eligible consumers, with a focus on Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

To successfully apply for this position you will need:

1. Bachelor's degree in nursing, occupational therapy, social work, or psychology including current registration with the Australian Health Practitioners Regulation Agency (AHPRA) or AASW where appropriate.
2. Recent demonstrated experience in a mental health, alcohol, and other drug and/or forensic health setting.
3. Understanding of relevant legislation and regulations related to the delivery of forensic mental health services.
4. Ability to provide vaccination status information that meets the requirements for healthcare workers.
