The Recovery Support Worker will work with people affected by the floods to provide information, advice and support and assistance in applying for grants and referrals to sources of support (such as financial counselling and mental health support). The Recovery Support Worker will ensure that people have a seamless experience in accessing a range of services and support requirements. The Recovery Support Worker will aim to empower people to take control of their recovery journey by working to build capacity by adopting a strengths base to enable people to self-determine the level of support required.

The Program aims to support people in a trauma-informed way, tailor to a person's individual needs and align with any existing service provision.
