The Position

The role of the position is to coordinate and facilitate the Refugee Cancer Services pilot project. The position will collaborate with project partners to identify enablers and barriers to optimize cancer care (including screening treatment and palliative care) for those of Karen and Afghan refugee background, while building capacity of the cancer service providers and systems to optimize cancer care for the target group. The position will work closely with bilingual staff of refugee lived experience to implement manage and evaluate the project.

To successfully apply for this position you will need:

1. Demonstrated ability and experience in project oversight/management, needs analysis, program design, evaluation and report writing.
2. Experience in working closely with the refugee communities and an understanding of the pre- and post- settlement complexities of the project target groups, particularly their health status and beliefs.
3. Demonstrated communication skills and community engagement with the project target group.
4. Experience in working with bilingual, bicultural staff of refugee background.
