The Position

This position is a key contact in coordination of and delivery of refugee health services which includes building refugee sensitive practice for health and wellbeing service providers and enhancing refugee health pathways. Working with the BCHS Settlement Services and Cultural Diversity teams and key stakeholders this role will enhance optimal health and wellbeing settlement outcomes for local communities of lived refugee experience.

BCHS is seeking to recruit a skilled Refugee Health Nurse who has well developed clinical and communication skills who can work with community service providers and partners to optimize health settlement outcomes.

To successfully apply for this position, you will need:

1. Registered General Nurse Division 1 with current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia via the Australian Health Practitioner Agency.
2. Two years or more nursing experience in Community/Public Health practice
3. Experience in working with multicultural communities and/or communities of refugee lived experience is preferred.
4. A sound knowledge of community health principles and understanding of the social model of health.
