Mental Health Clinician

45.6 to 76 hours per fortnight (0.6- 1.0 FTE) Fixed term to 30 June 2024

The Position

The Mental Health Clinician will provide counselling, clinical care and treatment of referrals to community members across a broad age range, with a strong focus on community members with lived refugee experience.

The Mental Health Clinician will be skilled and capable in the delivery of community based mental health. Clinicians are sought to work with child and adolescent programs, suicide prevention, families engaged with out of home care, and community members with complex mental health needs.

To successfully apply for this position you will need:

- 1. Current registration with APRHA or AASW, as appropriate, with mental health accreditation (psychologist, social worker, occupational therapist, mental health nurse).
- 2. Experience working with CALD communities and providing trauma-informed counselling with interpreter assistance desired.
- 3. Relevant accreditation or credentialing, enabling the provision of therapeutic services funded under Medicare and Primary Health Network (PTS, Mental Health Plans etc).
